

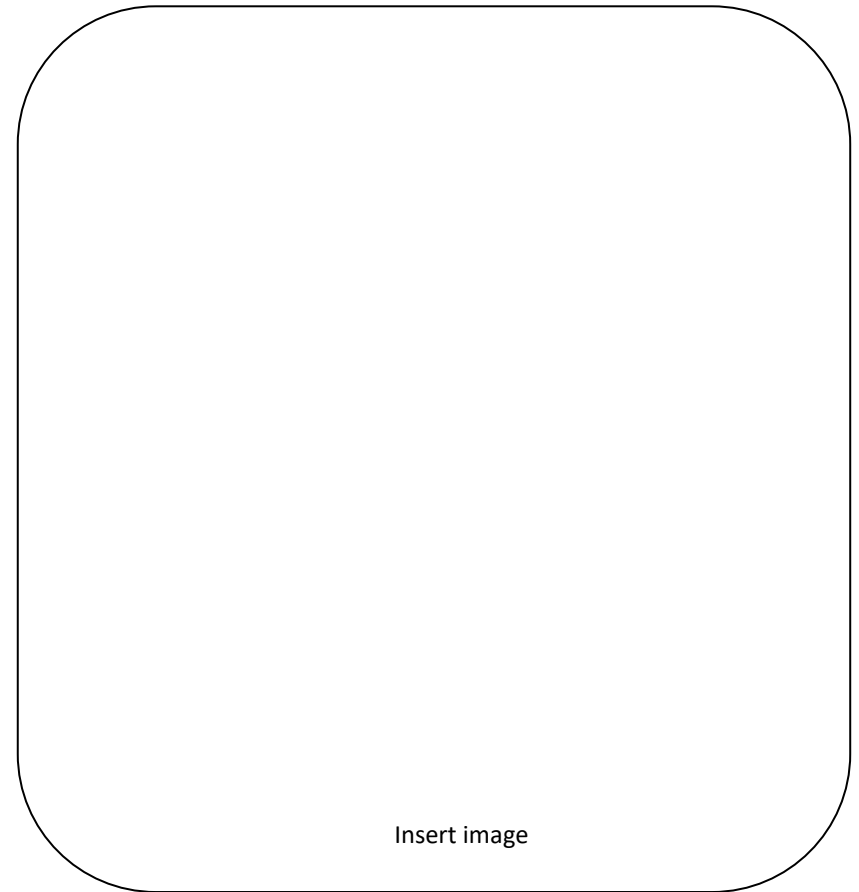


Slowly trace a path to the centre with your finger.

How to use your prayer journal ...

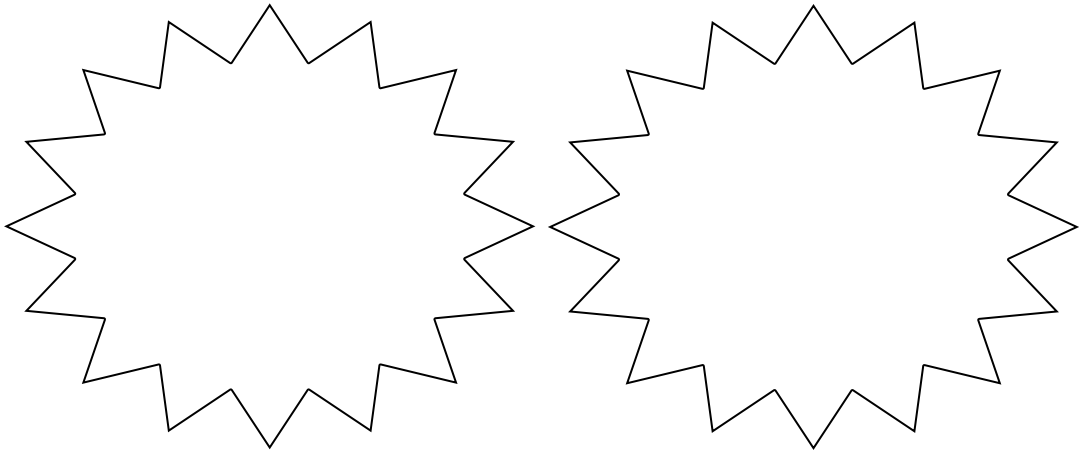
*Be still and know that I am God*

Whenever we journal we will play quiet music to help us to reflect and to remind us that this is a prayer time.

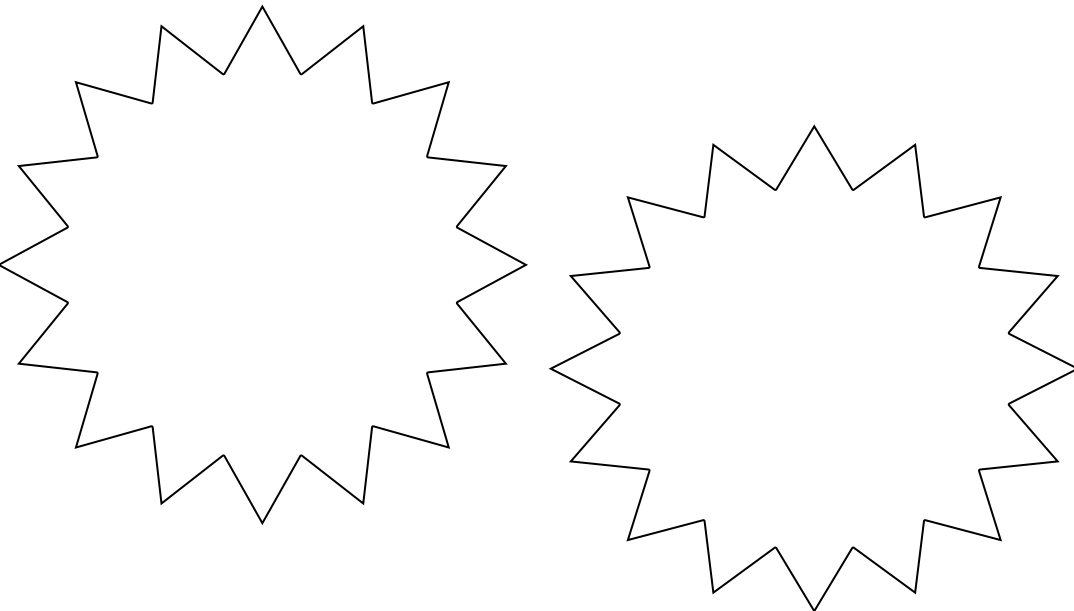
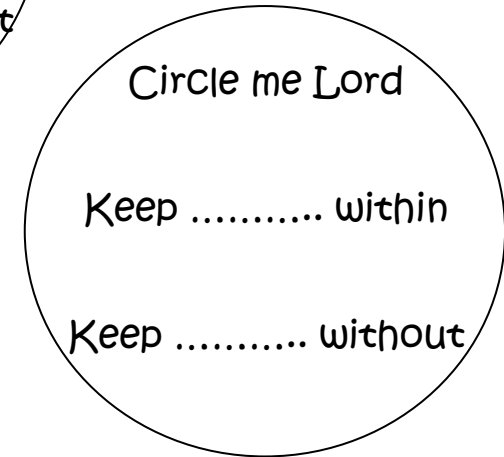
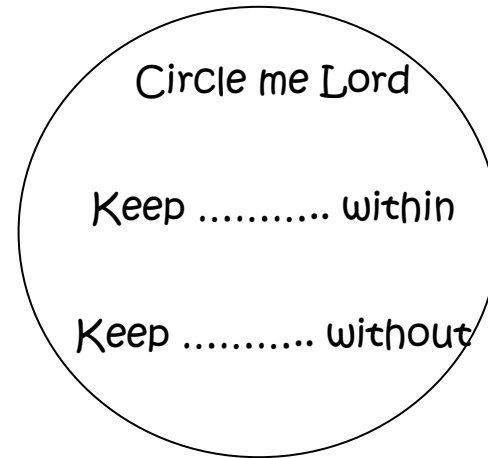
