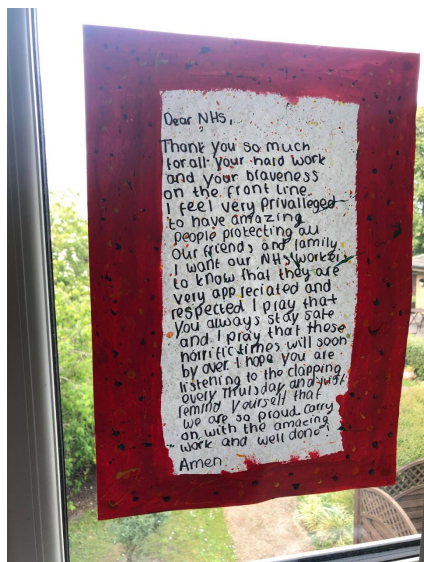


# Cardinal Hume School, Wrekenton Supporting the NHS 2020
